Summer Enrichment Week Summary



Student behavior has dramatically improved with **75%** reduction in lessons disrupted by a student needing to be removed, an **84%** reduction in the number of incidents leading to suspension and **50%** more positive behavior points being earned compared to last year!



Suspensions over academic year 24/25



"We are so proud of the progress the school has made."

Student attendance has risen by 4% which is a huge amount in attendance terms. By far the best rate of improvement in Suffolk. Staff attendance has also dramatically improved, with teachers who had poor attendance being replaced with ones who are in every day. 35% of our students achieved 100% attendance and have gone on a trip to Thorpe Park as a reward!

The Ambition Programme is ready to go; from September, the Y7 and some Y8s and Y9s to add one of three inspirational pathways for afterschool training and qualifications.
