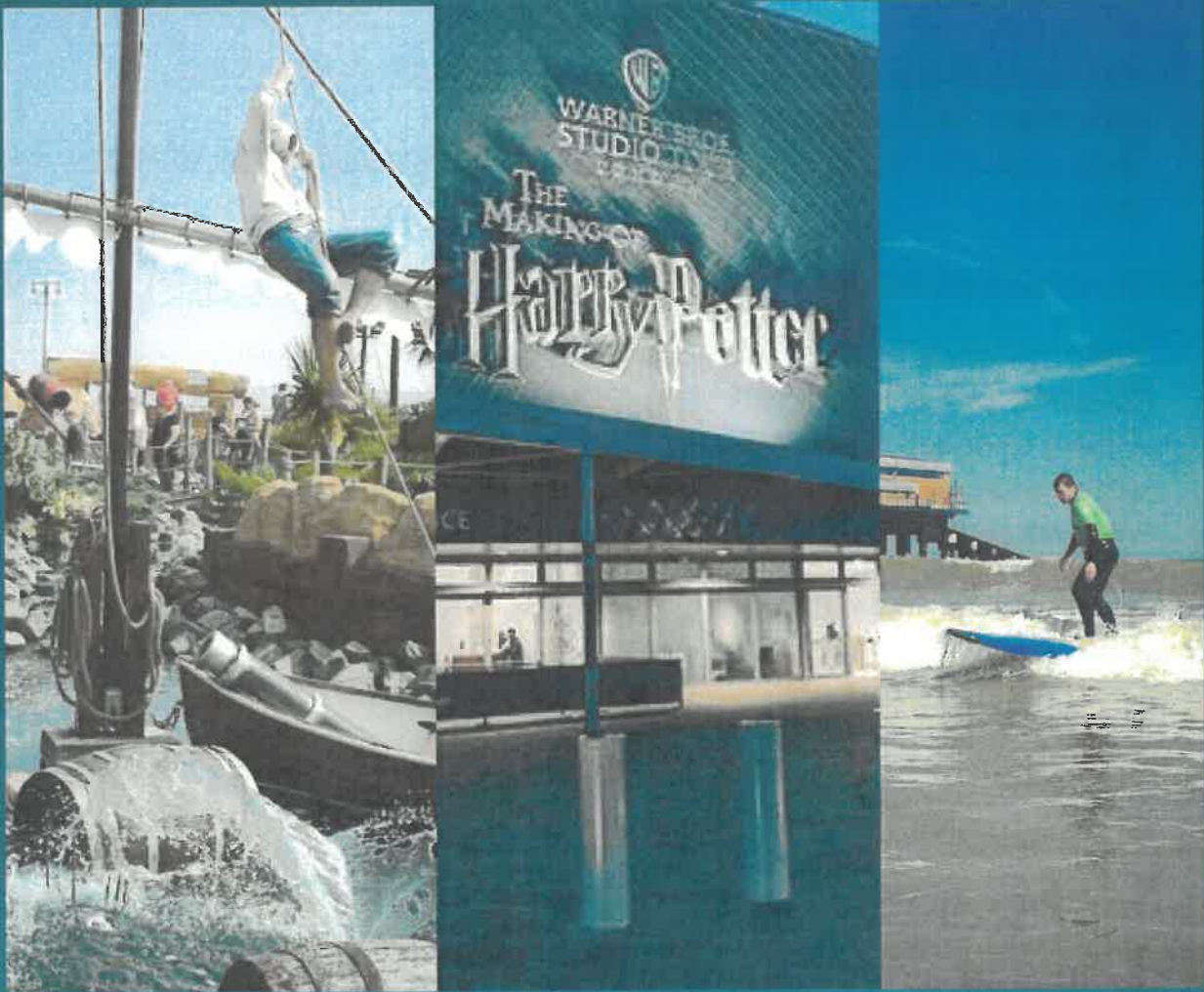

## MONDAY

No	Activity	Spaces	Costs	Description
1	Paintballing	31	£49.51	Designed and built to generate the best paintball experience, our outdoor arena make adrenaline-fuelled action possible. Compete in a range of awesome battle zones, including open woodland, a CQB close combat village, bunkers, bases and a full-scale mock church! Find it all here at Combat, the best outdoor activities venue in East Anglia!
2	Mosaic building	26	£5	Have a go at designing and creating your own mosaic piece of work based around a theme of your choice.
3	Gaming	28	Free	Take part in a range of different types and styles of gaming, whether is be computer-based gaming, tabletop or cards, there is bound to be a style of gaming suited to your style. Compete against others of play as a cooperative
4	Walberswick Crabbing	12	£5.50	Spend the day at Walberswick, starting with crabbing in the morning, complete to catch the most crabs. Followed by lunch and ice cream on the green then back to the beach for some paddling and fun.

## Payments

When parents/carers receive confirmation of the activity their child has been allocated, they will be given information as to what payments are required and when.

All final payments received by **19<sup>th</sup> June 2026**. \*Some trips may require an earlier payment; this will be communicated when activities have been allocated. Please do not delay your reply, even if you have not got your finances in place.

Prices shown are based on current quotes and the number of students expected to participate in each activity. Final prices will not be known until all students have made their selections.

The Education Act 1996 requires all school trips/activities to comply with these rules:

- As Activities Week will take place in school time, costs can only be met by voluntary contributions.
- Applications without a voluntary contribution will not be treated differently.
- The School has no funds to subsidise families who do not wish to pay.
- Activities may be cancelled if there are not sufficient voluntary contributions.
- Students registered for Free School Meals are entitled to request a reduction. For more information, please contact the school office.
- Should there be an overpayment of more than £5, this will be refunded following the trip.
- Regardless of whether it is mentioned explicitly in every occurrence, all payments for these activities are on a voluntary basis.
- In cases of genuine financial difficulty, please contact the school office.

# TUESDAY

No	Activity	Spaces	Costs	Description
1	Harry Potter Studios	48	£51	Walk in the footsteps of Harry Potter and explore the wonders of the wizarding world. Explore the set, enjoy a wizarding discussion about the studios and discover your inner Witch or Wizard.
2	Printmaking and Textiles	26	£5	Plan, design and print your own graphics or design onto a t-shirt or bag. Have you always wanted to explore your own fashion style? Have you wanted to learn how to create your own clothing? This is an opportunity to learn and use different printmaking techniques not usually learnt in the classroom.
3	Sport	28	Free	Take part in a range of different sporting activities, whether it is team games or individual activities. This is a great day to spend outside, enjoying the fresh air whilst getting active and trying new games.
4	Cromer Glide Surf School	12	£40.50	Ever wanted to learn how to surf and how to catch a wave? This could be for you! Firstly, we will spend the morning on the beach having a paddle followed by lunch. After lunch we will then take part in a surf school lesson where you will be kitted up with a wetsuit, shoes and a board and taught how to catch the waves. (This activity is weather dependent, if there are insufficient waves an alternative activity is provided by the school)
5	School Production	12	Free	Help the performers prepare for the school production of Grease, this could be taking on a small part of the production itself or helping with the stage crew.



# WEDNESDAY

No	Activity	Spaces	Costs	Description
1	Colchester Zoo	48	£23.50	Spend the day exploring Colchester Zoo in small groups, take a walk past the elephants and watch them being fed or take a trip on the land train and see the lemurs. This is a fun day of discovery at the Zoo.
2	Cake Baking and Clay Sculptures	16	£5	Enjoy a split day of baking cakes and sculpting with clay. Learn a range of different decorating techniques and create a delicious treat to take home. Then enjoy some sculpture, creating a piece of work out of clay.
3	STEM	16	Free	Enjoy a range of activities and tasks based around Science, Technology, engineering and Maths. Build contraptions, work in teams and complete in a variety of games.
4	School Production	12	Free	Help the performers prepare for the school production of Grease, this could be taking on a small part of the production itself or helping with the stage crew.
5	Crazy Golf GY	12	£21.60	How is your golfing? Why not come along and compete in some Pirate Crazy golf? Do you have what it takes to make the shot? We will start the day with two courses of crazy golf, followed by lunch, arcade and a paddle on the beach.
6	Geocaching - on foot	16	Free	Geocaching is a type of treasure hunt where people look for caches, or hidden stashes of objects. Seekers use global positioning system (GPS) maps to find hidden caches. Hidden around Beccles there are a number of hidden caches. Take a trip round to find as many as you can. It is usual to find small toys (think Christmas cracker type) hidden in these caches, but the rule is to leave something if you take something so have a few small, cheap things with you to trade! This activity will be a lot of walking so good shoes/boots and suitable clothing along with sunscreen is recommended!
